2017 FORTUNE 500 COMPANIES

Nine of the 20 *Fortune 500* companies headquartered in Houston are located Downtown. The Houston metro area ranks fourth in the country behind New York (63), Chicago (34) and Dallas-Ft. Worth (22). In total, Downtown is home to 62 companies on the 2017 Fortune 500 List.

Four Downtown companies moved up the ranks from 2016 to 2017: Waste Management moved from #221 (\$13 billion) to #201 (\$13.6 billion); Calpine moved from #402 (\$6.5 billion) to #400 (\$6.7 billion), and CenterPoint Energy moved from #363 (\$7.4 billion) to #362 (\$7.5 billion).
